SCHOLARSHIPS

- Scholarship for girl students admitted through CAP rounds.
- Freeship and Scholarships provided by Govt. of Maharashtra and Govt. of India for SC, ST, VJ, NT, OBC, SBC, SEBC, EBC, EWS candidates.

ADMISSION PROCESS

- Applying online for the MHT-CET exam through the official website of the State CET Cell.
- Announcement of MHT-CET results on the official website.
- Declaration of the merit list based on MHT-CET scores.
- Commencement of the Centralized Admission Process (CAP) for MHT-CET qualified candidates.
- Registration for CAP rounds and uploading of required documents.
- Document verification through e-scrutiny centers or at Facilitation Centers (FCs).
- Option Form Filling – Candidates fill in their college and course preferences for each CAP round.
- Seat Allotment (Round-wise) – Candidates may accept the allotted seat or participate in further rounds.
- Reporting to the allotted college – Report to the institute, pay the admission fees and submit original documents within the specified deadline.
